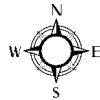
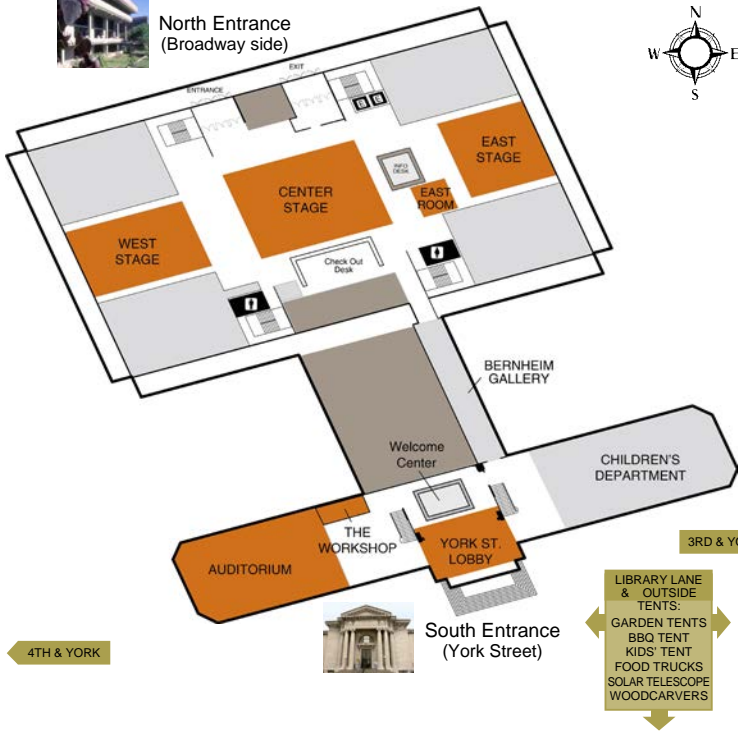

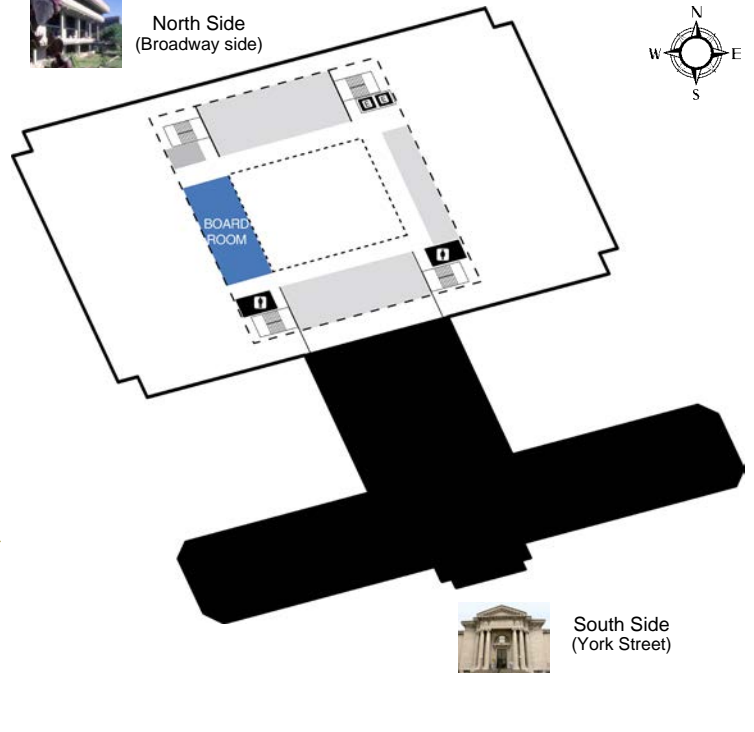
North Entrance

MEZZANINE LEVEL (North Side Only)



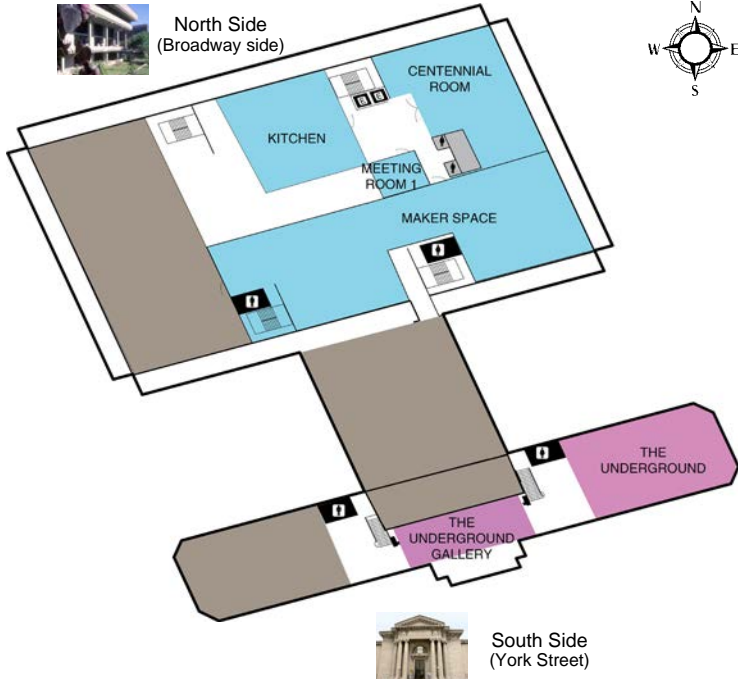
North Side

BASEMENT LEVEL*



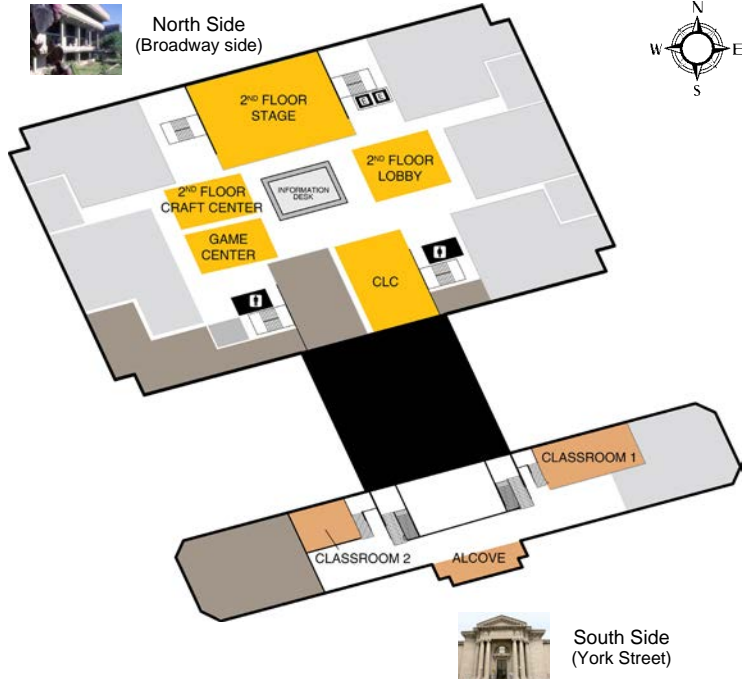
North Side
