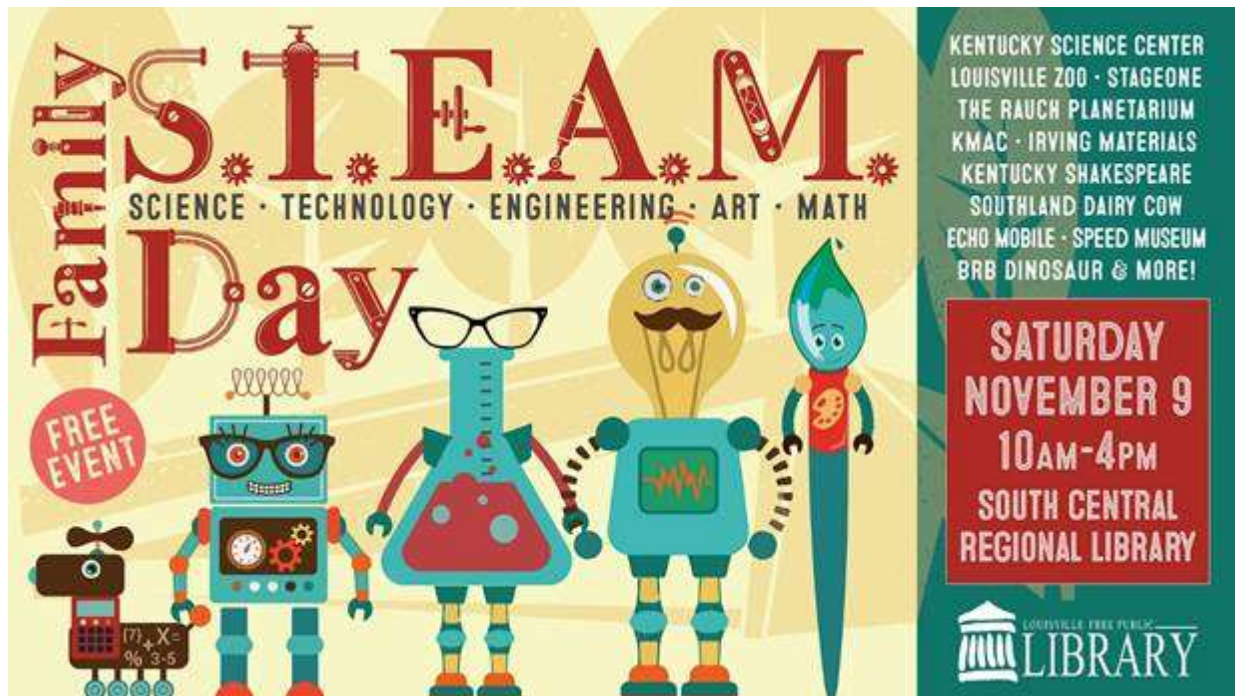

The BRB Dinosaur from Dinosaur Encounter will be on-hand for photo-ops, the ECHO Mobile will bring outdoor nature play to the South Central campus, and a real cow will be on hand from Southland Dairy. Kids can also enjoy musical performances by Evan and Vanessa, learn about TV puppetry from Gorp Gnimji, and explore the South Central Maker Lab. We will finish out the day with a 2-actor performance of
