## ***ENID: Generations of Women Sculptors*** **exhibit at the Main Library**

Opening Reception: Saturday, August 17, 5:30 – 7 p.m.

**LOUISVILLE, Ky. (August 13, 2019)** – The Louisville Free Public Library will host a new art exhibit starting this Saturday, as part of the year-long celebration of Louisville sculptor Enid Yandell. *ENID: Generations of Women Sculptors* is a collective of female sculptors founded in 1998 and named for Yandell, whose goal is to encourage, educate, and mentor women artists, students, and each other. The opening reception of *ENID: Generations of Women Sculptors* will include an historic interpretation of Enid Yandell, courtesy of the [Frazier History Museum](#). The opening reception is **Saturday, August 17<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m. at the Main Library, 301 York Street**. The exhibit will be on display in the Bernheim Gallery at the Main Library August 17-October 8.

Other upcoming *Enid Yandell: A Life of Art and Activism* programming at the Library includes the *Enid Yandell in WWI Paris* Fast Class. In this talk, Filson Historical Society associate curator Jana Meyer will explore Enid's experiences in Paris during the early weeks of World War I, as well as her subsequent involvement in relief efforts to ease the suffering of French civilians. This Fast Class will be at the Main Library on Thursday, September 12 at 6:30 p.m. The program is free and open to the public, but registration is requested. On Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup> at 2 p.m., children ages 5 and up are invited to *All Boxed Up*, a sculpture-making workshop facilitated by Paula Keppie, Jacque Parsley, and Melinda Walters, members of the ENID: Generations of Women Sculptors collective. The workshop will incorporate ideas from women sculptors in honor of Enid Yandell.

October 6, 2019 will mark the 150th birthday of Enid Yandell, the renowned sculptor born in Louisville, known the world over for her larger than life work, and locally for her Olmsted Park fixtures.
