

Social issues impact all of us – but who decides what counts as a social problem? And how do individuals and communities create meaningful change? This engaging foursession course, led by Bellarmine sociology



professor Ainsley Lambert-Swain, invites participants of all backgrounds to explore how social problems are defined, framed, and addressed.

Through interactive discussions and handson activities, participants will examine how public conversations are shaped by media, experts, and grassroots efforts. 
